Reporting to the Supervisor, and supported by the Professional Practice Mentor, the Head Start ECE supports the planning and implementation of the Early Learning program. The ECE plays a key role on the inter-disciplinary team providing Early Learning Programming and services that are inclusive and responsive to the diversity of the populations we serve.

Responsibilities

- Works with an inter-disciplinary team comprised of a Teacher, Social Worker, and Speech Language Pathologist to support classroom management of Early Learning programs.
- Establishes and support an inclusive early learning environment that stimulates the emotional, social, physical, cognitive, communication and creative growth of children.
- Establishes supportive and respectful relationships among staff and the children, their families and the community.
- Monitors and provides documentation to improve program quality.
