Family Resilience Worker Full Time Temporary Position

ABC Head Start is accepting applications for a Family Resilience Worker position. Reporting to the Supervisor, and supported by the Professional Practice Mentor, the Family Resilience Worker supports children and families to reach their full potential. The Family Resilience Worker plays a key role on the inter-disciplinary team providing family engagement programming and services that are responsive to the diversity of the populations we serve.

Responsibilities:

- Work with families to identify priorities and develop action steps to address those priorities in their individual and family life
- Exploring and creating meaningful opportunities to engage families
- Support intake of new families into ABC Head Start Society programs
- Advocating for families in crisis, assisting with problem solving and goal planning to increase their confidence in meeting the needs of their children and family
- Assisting families to connect with community resources, and arranging case conferences when necessary
- Supporting self advocacy practices to assist families to become their own best advocates
- Planning, organizing and facilitating family gatherings to ensure the group reflects the needs and interests
 of families
- Spending time with children regularly in the classroom and on home visits to speak about their progress
